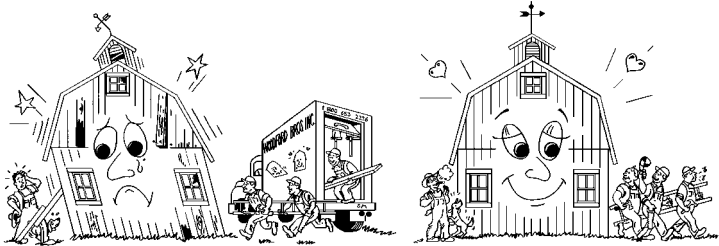

The Empire Suite is the largest accommodation in the barn. It has 2 bedrooms with a queen size bed in each room, and a sunken living room with a gas fireplace, full-size sleeper and a twin-size sleeper. Altogether, this suite can sleep 7. It also has an eat-in kitchen, full bathroom and a half bath with a washer and dryer. Additional treats are the 2 balconies for this space. Spacious and comfortable. It is on the 2nd floor, stairway only. **Rates:** \$199.00 for 2 adults. \$49.00/each additional adult. Each consecutive night stay is \$174/2 adults and \$49/ea. additional adult.

The Ginger Gold Loft is quite spacious and is designed for 2 adults. There is a great room/kitchen/dining with a gas stove and French doors that open to the master bedroom. (1 queen bed). The luxurious bathroom has a large, walk-in shower, washer and dryer and opens to the master bedroom and great room. This suite also has a balcony and is on the 2nd floor, stairway only. **Rates:** \$149.00 the first night, \$124.00 each consecutive night.

The Jona Gold and Jona Mac rooms are on the first floor in the main house. Each room can accommodate 4 people. Both rooms have easy staircases to a loft that has a queen bed. The first floor of each room has a sofa sleeper for 2.

These rooms will share a bathroom off the "common area". The common area includes a billiards table, wet bar (not stocked), entertainment center and baby grand piano. **Rates:** \$99.00/2 adults and \$49/each additional adult. \$74.00/2 adults for each consecutive night and \$49/each additional adult.
